### Introduction


The page of the Biblioteca Madre María Teresa Guevara allows you to search for information resources in various ways to meet different purposes. One of these alternatives is to search for information by printed, digital, or audiovisual formats.

## Why Might You Need to Search for Information Resources in a Particular Format?

For example, you may need to find the textbook for a class. For this, you will need to search for printed resources. If you need to find newspaper articles for a class, it is convenient to search in a news database. If you need to see what is said about a topic you will research, finding an electronic book can help. If you are looking to watch a documentary, it may be convenient to check audiovisual resource databases.

# ¿How Can You Search for Print Resources Through the Library's Webpage?

- 1. Visit the page: <a href="https://biblioteca.sagrado.edu/">https://biblioteca.sagrado.edu/</a>
- 2. Select the box that says, "physical resources"




3. Enter your keywords in the blank space to search.

You can search for book titles, author names, or specific subjects.


For example, you can find out:

- If the library has the title Social Sciences: Society and Contemporary Culture
- What books we have by the author Paulo Coelho
- What print resources cover the topic of self-esteem



4. When you choose a title, you'll be able to see a detailed description of it.


This includes details such as the library collection where it's located and its call number, which helps you locate it.




- 1. Book details
- 2. Library collection where it is found
- 3. Where to find it on the shelf (Call number)

- 5. At the left side, you'll find a column you can use to filter results by
  - a. Author
  - b. Format
  - c. Language
  - d. Publication date
  - e. Subject
  - f. Material type

(For example: books, continuous resources, electronic resources, audio cassette, periodical, etc.)
